Important Information about the drinking water in school

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you about an issue we have encountered with the drinking water in school today. Due to a noticeable change in its colour, we made the decision to stop our school community from using the tap water for drinking to ensure the health and safety of all our pupils and staff.

To address the situation, today we have provided all classrooms with bottled water, and will continue to supply bottled water to all pupils until the Water Testing Team has deemed our water safe to drink. Our site management team is presently investigating this matter in school, and we will keep you updated as soon as more information becomes available.

In the meantime, if you are able, we kindly ask that you send bottled water with your child until the situation is resolved. Additionally, we have taken further precautions by setting up extra sanitising stations in all toilets.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to resolve this matter. Please rest assured that the health and safety of our pupils is our top priority.
