

Uniform

- We do remind your children to put their sweatshirt and cardigan in their tray. Sometimes they forget!
- Please clearly name every item including hats, gloves etc
- Stitched in ones or a sharpie pen seem to work best.
- · Please regularly check that your child's name has not fallen off or washed off
- Be mindful that it is a working uniform and that it will get messy during this reception year
- Please work with your child on being able to zip up their coat independently.

Homework

Reading books and library books to be returned to school on a Monday. We will then change them and they will be sent home on a Tuesday.

Initially this will be a pre reading book where the focus is to develop language, talking about the pictures, telling a story from them, holding the book and turning the pages. Then will be a phonetically decodable book matched to the phonics sounds that your child knows.

Talk about cards to help your child to develop their vocabulary.

We also post on Class Dojo practical activities to do at home to develop your child's numerical skills linked to what the children have been learning in school.

Reading Record Books

In your child's reading record book, please can you write down the title of the book that you are reading and the date on which it has been read, as well as your initials. On each day that your child reads a book or part of a book, a dojo will be awarded to your child. Your teacher will total up the amount of reads your child has completed in a week and write this in your reading record book. These will then be added to your child's overall dojo total for the week. This will hopefully be an added incentive to encourage your child to read as much and as frequently as possible. Teachers will always read and acknowledge any comments written in your child's reading record book and address any issues raised. Books will be sent out on a Tuesday and should be returned to school on the following Monday. This will give teaching staff time to change your child's book and read any comments written in reading record books.

Class Dojo

Class Dojo is our school app. It is our primary way of us informing parents of what is occurring in school and externally. There is a main school story and also year group class story's.

Dojo is a two way communication tool.

There is a portfolio section on Dojo that you can add pictures from home. You can share your child's WOW moments from home, with us in school. You can add pictures of work, experiences, out of school clubs, any achievements that your child has done at home, that makes you go WOW!!

One for Class 2 Miss Crofts and Mrs Woodhouse.

Which ever member of staff posts on the dojo pages, the information will be for all children and parents.
