

#### Worship Planner 2024 – 2025 Summer 2


## Theme for Collective Worship 2024 - 2025

Exploring how our school's core values serve as a guiding framework throughout life, much like a transport map. Each "values line" represents a different path where we encounter inspirational figures, discover Bible stories, and learn practical ways to embody and live out these values every day.

### How this will work

- 1. Core Values as Routes
- 2. Bible Verses, how we can live out our values and Inspirational people as Stations
  - 3. Transfers we look at how different values can work together in real life

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## Monday & Tuesday Worship

### **Opening** -

**School Vision:** Begin by reciting or reflecting on the school's vision, setting the tone for the worship and aligning the community with the school's core values.

**Candle Lighting:** Light three candles to represent the Holy Trinity, creating a sacred space for reflection and worship.

**Theme:** Each worship during the Autumn Term will center around either a Bible verse, school vision or an inspirational person.

**Interactive Worship:** The worship leader should design an interactive session that helps children engage deeply with the chosen verse or learn from the life and example of the inspirational person.

Hymn: Linked to the key Value

**Prayer:** Conclude the worship with a prayer that reflects on the key value highlighted in the session. Follow this with the recitation of The Lord's Prayer and blessing



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## Wednesday Class Worship

### Opening –

**School Vision**: Begin by reciting or reflecting on the school's vision, grounding the worship in the core principles that guide the school community.

Candle Lighting: Light a candle to symbolise the start of the worship, creating a calm and focused atmosphere.

#### Class Worship – Tell the story – Teach the story

**Engagement**: Ensure the worship is interactive, encouraging participation from all students. This could include discussions, prayers, or shared reflections related to the theme.

**Activity**: Incorporate a brief, meaningful activity that reinforces the worship's message. The activities are available in the planning, these can be differentiated for Team 2 – Y1,Y2,Y3 and Team 3 – Y4,Y5,Y6.

**Music/Hymn:** A piece of music that links to the key message can be used for reflection or a hymn used to share a collective song.

**Worship Record Book**: Conclude by recording the activity or key moments from the worship in the Worship Record Book. This serves as evidence of participation and reflection, and as a keepsake of the class's spiritual journey throughout the year.

#### **Prayers Activities:**

Week 1: "Faith Footsteps" – Children write or draw something they are trusting God for on a footprint cut-out. These are placed on the floor/pathway to symbolise walking in faith.

Week 2: "Heart Garland" – Children write the name of someone they want to show love to on a heart. These hearts are strung together to create a class-wide love chain displayed on your worship table.

Week 3: "Caring Hands" – Children draw around their hands and write/draw one thing they will do to show care (e.g., pick up litter, help a friend). These are displayed as a collage of helping hands.

Week 4: "Prayer Basket" – Children bring symbolic items (drawings of toys, food, talents) to a basket on the stage and pray for those who have less. Encourage pupils to think of ways to give or share during the week.

Week 5: "Seed of Growth" – Each child draws a sunflower and writes how they want to grow (e.g., be braver, kinder). This links to growth in the light of Christ.
