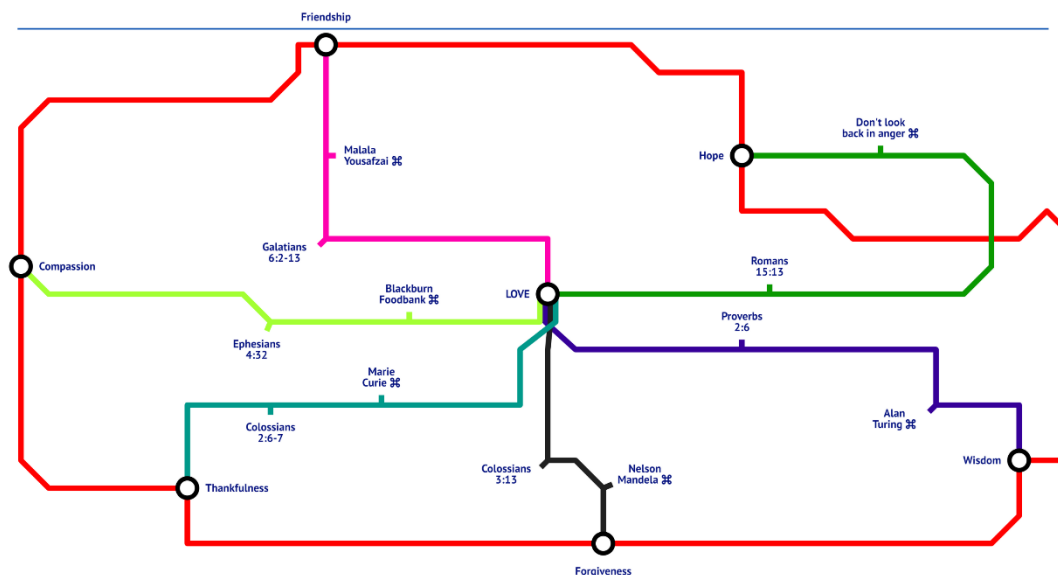
How this will work

Monday & Tuesday Worship

Opening -

School Vision: Begin by reciting or reflecting on the school's vision, setting the tone for the worship and aligning the community with the school's core values.

Candle Lighting: Light three candles to represent the Holy Trinity, creating a sacred space for reflection and worship.

Theme: Each worship during the Autumn Term will center around either a Bible verse or an inspirational person.

Interactive Worship: The worship leader should design an interactive session that helps children engage deeply with the chosen verse or learn from the life and example of the inspirational person.

Hymn: Linked to the key Value

Prayer: Conclude the worship with a prayer that reflects on the key value highlighted in the session. Follow this with the recitation of The Lord's Prayer and blessing

School Vision: Begin by reciting or reflecting on the school's vision, grounding the worship in the core principles that guide the school community.

Candle Lighting: Light a candle to symbolise the start of the worship, creating a calm and focused atmosphere.

Class Worship – Tell the story – Teach the story

Engagement: Ensure the worship is interactive, encouraging participation from all students. This could include discussions, prayers, or shared reflections related to the theme.

Activity: Incorporate a brief, meaningful activity that reinforces the worship's message. The activities are available in the planning, these can be differentiated for Team 2 – Y1,Y2,Y3 and Team 3 – Y4,Y5,Y6.

Music/Hymn: A piece of music that links to the key message can be used for reflection or a hymn used to share a collective song.

Worship Record Book: Conclude by recording the activity or key moments from the worship in the Worship Record Book. This serves as evidence of participation and reflection, and as a keepsake of the class's spiritual journey throughout the year.

Summer Term of Prayer Tasks:

Week 1: **Alphabet Prayer** Play a game where you go around the room each taking a letter of the alphabet and naming something beginning with that letter that brings you joy; A= Animals, B = Birthdays, C = Chocolate, D = Dancing, etc. When you get to 'Z' go back to 'A' if necessary to make sure everyone has a turn. All shout 'Thank you God' followed by a big AMEN!

Week 2: **Ribbon** Give some children a piece of ribbon – sometimes we receive special looking presents with ribbon wrapped around them. Tie your piece of ribbon to something (for example the branch of a tree, or a length of cord) and pray giving thanks for Jesus who is the best gift ever! **Can we add ribbons all around school!**

Week 3: **Fingerprints** Use a little paint or ink on your finger and use your fingerprint to make the shape of a person on a piece of paper. Remember that your fingerprint is unique to you, and that each person is unique and precious to God. Pray, thanking God that he made you just the way you are.

Week 4: **Prayer Bands** Take a strip of paper that is long enough to go around your wrist. Write the names of people or places on the strip of paper that you want to pray for, then put the strip of paper on your wrist, sticking the end down with tape. Hold your prayer
