This half term we would like children to work on their fluency of telling the time. We are asking that parents spend 5 minutes (or more) with their child each week playing an interactive game with the clock to improve their ability to tell the time. The clock is situated on the playground outside the Year 3 classrooms, should you wish to use it!

Instructions for the game.

To play this game you will need a dice or use the cut out below. Cut out the clock hands below.

Roll the dice up to 3 times and add the totals together to make the hour hand.

Eg. $2 + 5 + 3 = 8$

Roll the dice again and multiply the answer by 5 to make the minutes.

Eg. $3 \times 5 = 15$

The time on the clock should show quarter past 8. Ask your child to tell you the time.

Each correct answer is worth 1 point.

Record the number of points your child scores within 5 minutes, each week, in the grid on the reverse. Please hand the completed sheet to the class teacher on Tuesday 20th May. Children who have made great progress may be invited to play beat the teacher at Splat!
