

Redeemer Fundraisers Cash Prize Draw

Information & Terms

1. Draw Information

The **Redeemer Fundraisers Cash Prize Draw** (previously known as the **50-50 Draw**) is a lottery organised by Redeemer Fundraisers to raise funds for **The Redeemer School**.

For the purposes of this document, the Redeemer Fundraisers Cash Prize Draw may be referred to as **the 'Cash Prize Draw', the 'CPD' or 'the lottery'**. These terms all refer to the same draw.

The basic principle of the CPD is that 50% of the money received through ticket sales is added directly to the fundraising total for The Redeemer School. The remaining 50% is allocated to prizes, which are distributed across three prize categories and awarded in monthly draws.

The 2026/27 CPD will comprise **12 monthly draws**, beginning in **September 2026** and concluding in **August 2027**.

The CPD is registered with **Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council** as a small society lottery under the Gambling Act 2005, Schedule 11, Part 4.

The registered person for the CPD is **Ms Shannon Ainsworth**, Co-Chair of Redeemer Fundraisers. The principal office address for the CPD is the address of **The Redeemer School**.

2. Entry and Ticket Cost

Each entry costs **£1 per monthly draw**, with the full cost of **£12 for all 12 draws** payable before the first draw takes place.

Entries may be made at any point during the school year. Where an entry is made after the CPD has commenced, the amount payable will be calculated according to the number of remaining draws.

All entrants must be **aged 16 or over** at the time of entry.

The CPD is open to all eligible entrants aged 16 or over. There are no restrictions on entry based on an entrant's relationship with The Redeemer School or Redeemer Fundraisers.

Each valid entry will be allocated a unique entry number by Redeemer Fundraisers. Numbers are allocated as entries are received and registered, and entrants cannot request or select a specific number. Tickets showing your allocated number will be distributed via the named child or member of staff listed on your entry form. These tickets act as your receipt for all 12 draws and do not need to be presented to claim a prize.

3. Draw Dates and Arrangements

The monthly draws will normally take place during **Friday Morning Worship** towards the end of each calendar month.

The August 2027 draw will take place during **July 2027**, as The Redeemer School is closed during August.

If a scheduled draw is unable to take place during the relevant calendar month due to changes to the school calendar, school closure, or the availability of Redeemer Fundraisers committee members, the draw will take place at the **next available opportunity**.

Every effort will be made to notify entrants of any change to a scheduled draw date where reasonably possible.

There will always be **12 draws during the 2026/27 CPD year**, regardless of any changes to the individual draw dates.

4. Prize Fund and Prize Calculation

The value of the prizes will be determined by the total number of entries in the CPD.

For example, if there are **100 entries**, each costing £12 for the year, the total amount collected will be **£1,200**.

- **50% (£600)** will be added to the fundraising total for The Redeemer School.
- The remaining **50% (£600)** will form the prize fund.
- The prize fund will be divided equally across the 12 monthly draws, giving a monthly prize fund of **£50**.
- The monthly prize fund will then be divided between the three winning entries as follows:
 - **1st prize – 50% (£25)**
 - **2nd prize – 30% (£15)**
 - **3rd prize – 20% (£10)**

The above figures are provided as an example only. Actual prize values will vary depending on the total number of entries received.

The prize fund for each draw will be calculated based on the total number of paid entries included in the CPD.

In accordance with the guidelines for small society lotteries, 50% of the proceeds from the CPD goes towards the purpose of Redeemer Fundraisers – fundraising for The Redeemer School. This is above the minimum 20% required for a small society lottery.

5. How Winners Are Selected

Winning entry numbers will be selected at random during each monthly draw.

The lottery is drawn using **numbered tokens**. One token is drawn from a container for each prize. The tokens are only made available for the draw once all entry numbers for that month's draw have been finalised.

Three winning entries will be drawn for each monthly draw.

The winning entries will be drawn in prize order:

1. The first number drawn will receive **1st prize**.
2. The second number drawn will receive **2nd prize**.
3. The third number drawn will receive **3rd prize**.

Once a number has been drawn, it will not be returned to the draw for the purpose of selecting another prize in that same monthly draw.

Only valid and fully paid entries will be eligible to win a prize.

6. Payment of Prizes

Prizes will be paid by **cheque**.

Winning cheques will be returned home with the child or member of staff named on the entrant's entry form who attends or works at The Redeemer School.

If you do not receive your winning cheque, or there is a problem with the cheque, please contact Redeemer Fundraisers via redeemercepfundraisers@gmail.com and we will rectify the problem.

7. How to Enter

Entries can be made in either of the following ways:

- By completing the paper entry form available with the CPD information letter from The Redeemer School.

If you require assistance completing an entry, or are unable to use either of these methods, please contact Redeemer Fundraisers at redeemercepfundraisers@gmail.com or speak to the school office, who will contact the committee on your behalf.

8. Payment Methods

Payment for CPD entries can be made by:

- Bank transfer
- Cash
- Cheque

Full payment instructions and bank details are provided in the CPD information letter and in Section 2 of the online entry form.

If a payment is not received or cannot be attributed to an entry before a draw takes place, the entry will not be valid for that month's draw.

If a payment is subsequently received or matched and is greater than the amount required for the remaining draws, a refund will be provided for the overpayment.

9. Entry Information

It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that the information provided on the entry form is complete and accurate.

If incorrect or incomplete information is identified, we will make reasonable attempts to contact the entrant to correct the information. However, Redeemer Fundraisers cannot be responsible for issues arising from information that has been provided incorrectly or is incomplete.

10. Your Data

To register and administer your entry in the CPD, Redeemer Fundraisers needs to collect certain personal information. This information is used solely to administer the lottery, maintain accurate entry records and contact entrants where there is an issue with an entry or payment.

The telephone or mobile number provided will only be used to contact you when, for example:

- a payment cannot be matched to an entry;
- information required to register an entry is missing or unclear; or
- there is another issue relating directly to your CPD entry.

Information collected through both online and paper entry forms will be collated into a spreadsheet and stored within the **Redeemer Fundraisers Google Drive**, alongside the relevant entry information.

Access to the Google Drive is restricted to current members of the Redeemer Fundraisers committee who require access to administer the CPD.

The information will be retained for the period required for the proper administration of the CPD and in accordance with applicable lottery and data protection requirements.

Where a paper copy of the entry or winner information is produced for the purposes of administering a draw, it will be securely destroyed by shredding once it is no longer required.

By submitting an entry to the CPD, you acknowledge and agree that Redeemer Fundraisers may collect, store and use the information you provide for the purposes of administering the lottery, processing your entry, conducting the draws, contacting you where necessary and paying prizes.

11. Acceptance of Terms

By entering the CPD, entrants are deemed to have **read and accepted the information and terms set out in this document**.
