Colours are different to Reception books.

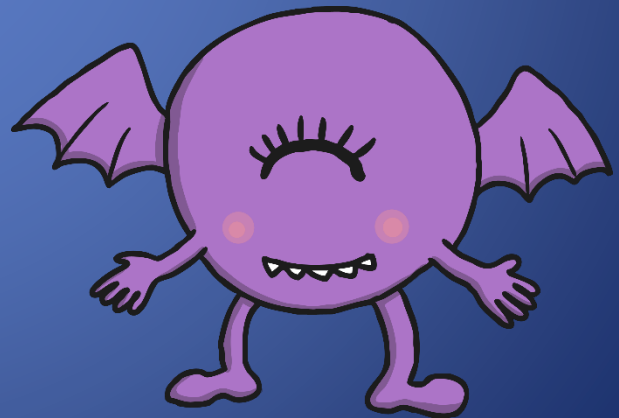
Children will be encouraged to take own books out ready to be changed.

Children are on a level higher (instructional read) in the Classroom and easy read for home.

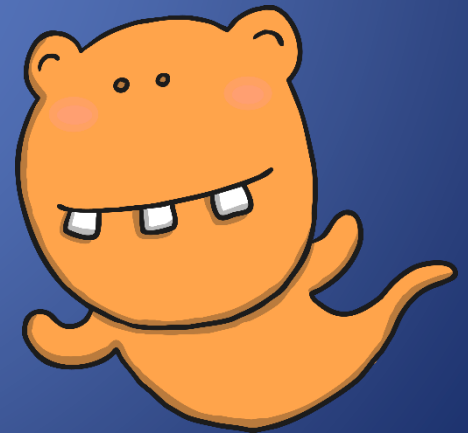
Phonics screening

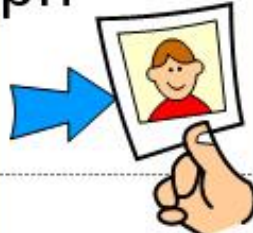
