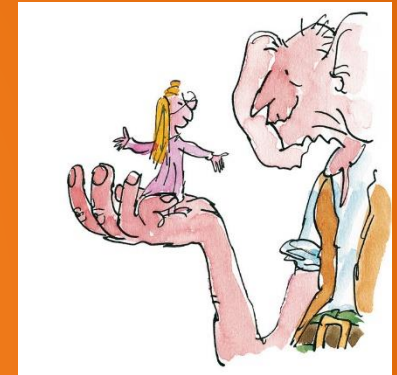

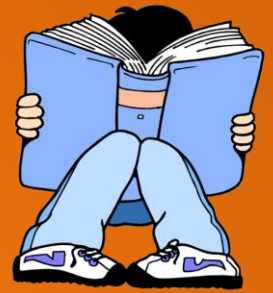


# P.E
