

Year 3 Website statements for Autumn Term

During the Autumn Term the children will.....

- Learn where France is in the world
- Begin to practise pronunciation and intonation skills in the new language
- Begin to explore memory techniques to remember and recall new language
- Practise listening, speaking and reading in the target language and experimenting with the writing of simple words
- To begin to explore the phoneme-grapheme links in words
- Learn how Christmas is celebrated in France

Language to be taught:

- simple greetings
- learn how to ask and answer what your name is
- how to ask and answer simple questions about how you feel
- numbers up to 10 and beyond
- days of the week
- months of the year
- how to say what day of the week it is and what month it is
- vocabulary and greetings associated with the festival of Christmas

Year 4 Website statements for Autumn Term

In the Autumn Term the children will.....

- learn to recall and re-use familiar core language in new contexts
- continue to practise the correct pronunciation and intonation of the target language using native speaker sound files
- build confidence in spoken personal information dialogues
- build on prior knowledge of nouns and use of articles with nouns
- identify similarities and differences between nouns in French and English
- to be able to recognise cognates and semi-cognates to aid reading comprehension skills
- recognise and pronounce correctly recurring phonemes in words
- to build on the language skills of memory and recall
- understand and respond to spoken and written commands
- speak, read and write dialogues based on personal information

Language to be taught:

- greetings and questions and answers based on personal information e.g. name, feelings, where you live etc
- recap on numbers to 20 and how to write (focus on phonemes).
- Nouns related to objects found in the classroom. Look at feminine, masculine and plural nouns
- How to ask ' Do you have a pen/pencil?' and reply.
- Revise and extend colours learnt last year in the context of a Bonfire Night Poem
- Revise and extend classroom instructions
- Vocabulary associated with Christmas
